You'll want to copy these at first until you get used to drawing them. <u>Don't worry</u> if your own doodles don't look exactly like the pictures. They express your own style, and that's great!

It IS important, however, that you get familiar with and internalize the basic principles, especially as concern the eyebrows, eyes and mouth. These are what make your doodles "read".


Try to FEEL the emotion you are expressing as you draw. It's a little like being an actor. That's how they do it at Disney!


Eventually your feelings will start flowing out of your pen or pencil and you won't have to think about it as much. It will be as natural as writing in a language you know.


Then you will experience the REAL joy of doodling, and so will everyone who sees you doodles!






